RIDDLE ME THIS!

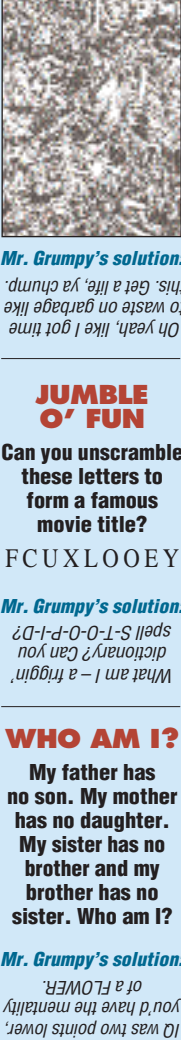
What has three ears in the morning, two noses at noon and one eye at night?
